It is a chance to improve your horse's mental and physical agility from the comfort of their own yard, without the time, cost, and hassle of travelling to a different venue.

The session is tailored to the horse and rider's abilities (there is no obligation to do any exercise that you don't feel is suitable for you or your horse, including cantering), and specific areas of improvement can be targeted if required, e.g. helping to improve bend, engagement, rhythm, etc.

What is a Pole Party

A Fancy Footwork Pole Party is a unique opportunity to enjoy professional polework training without the hassle of travelling. This clinic is being brought directly to your yard, meaning there's no need to worry about transport or tricky loaders. If you have a young or green horse, a nervous partnership, or simply want to take part in a structured and fun training session, this is the perfect solution.

Polework is a great way to improve your horse's rhythm, balance, and flexibility while keeping sessions interesting. These clinics cater to a wide range of riders and abilities, from those looking for a confidence boost to those wanting to refine their skills.






How It Works

Each session lasts 45 minutes and runs in pairs, allowing for focused, tailored instruction while still enjoying the social aspect of training together. Riders of all ages are welcome, but you must be fully in control of your horse or pony to participate safely. The exercises are adaptable, so there is no obligation to canter-everything can be adjusted to suit your comfort level.

Once you book and pay for your space, it is non-transferable and non-refundable. However, if you can no longer attend, you are welcome to find a replacement rider from your yard to take your place. This must be arranged by you.

Timings & What to Expect

The clinic will start at 10 AM (unless otherwise arranged), with sessions running back-to-back throughout the day. Please arrive on time for your session, as each one will finish as scheduled, regardless of late arrivals.

The arena will be set up before the first session begins, and a variety of polework exercises will be used throughout the day. The layouts can be adapted to target specific areas of improvement, whether you're looking to refine straightness, develop rhythm, or simply add variety to your horse's training routine.






Weather Policy

If severe weather-such as heavy rain, high winds, or freezing conditions-makes it unsafe to run the clinic, a decision will be made the day before as to whether it will go ahead. If the event needs to be postponed, it will be rescheduled for the earliest possible date.

Please note that refunds will not be issued due to weatherrelated postponements. Instead, your booking will be transferred to the new date.
